Dear parent / carer,

As you may be aware the government have announced a scheme to provide a laptop / 4G router to any student in Year 10 who does not have internet access at home. This scheme is designed to support students who are at a significant disadvantage because they cannot access on line learning from home during the current lockdown.

The scheme is a loan system. A laptop / 4G router would be loaned to any eligible student for the duration of school closure. There will be a loan agreement to be signed and the laptop will have to be returned once school is re-opened. The entire scheme will be co-ordinated by the Hope Learning Trust on behalf of the school.

We are now putting together a list of any students who may be able to benefit from this scheme. Available laptops will be allocated according to need. We would be grateful if you could contact us either on laptops@grahamschool.org or by telephoning school on 01723 366451 if your child might be eligible for this scheme. Please contact us by Thursday 7 May. The only students entitled to access this scheme will be those who **cannot currently access on line learning from home.** We will collate our list of eligible students based on all the information we hold.
