





Graham School is a situated in a large site, however, subjects are usually taught in a dedicated building so remembering which building is which subject is much easier than remembering where all the rooms are!

- Stamp rewards during every lesson for excellent contribution to learning etc


Our rewards and behaviour systems are all located in the student planner.
These will be given out in September.


Here is an example of the rewards page. Students receive reward stamps from all staff in school and the points are added up and can be cashed in for prizes throughout the year.
