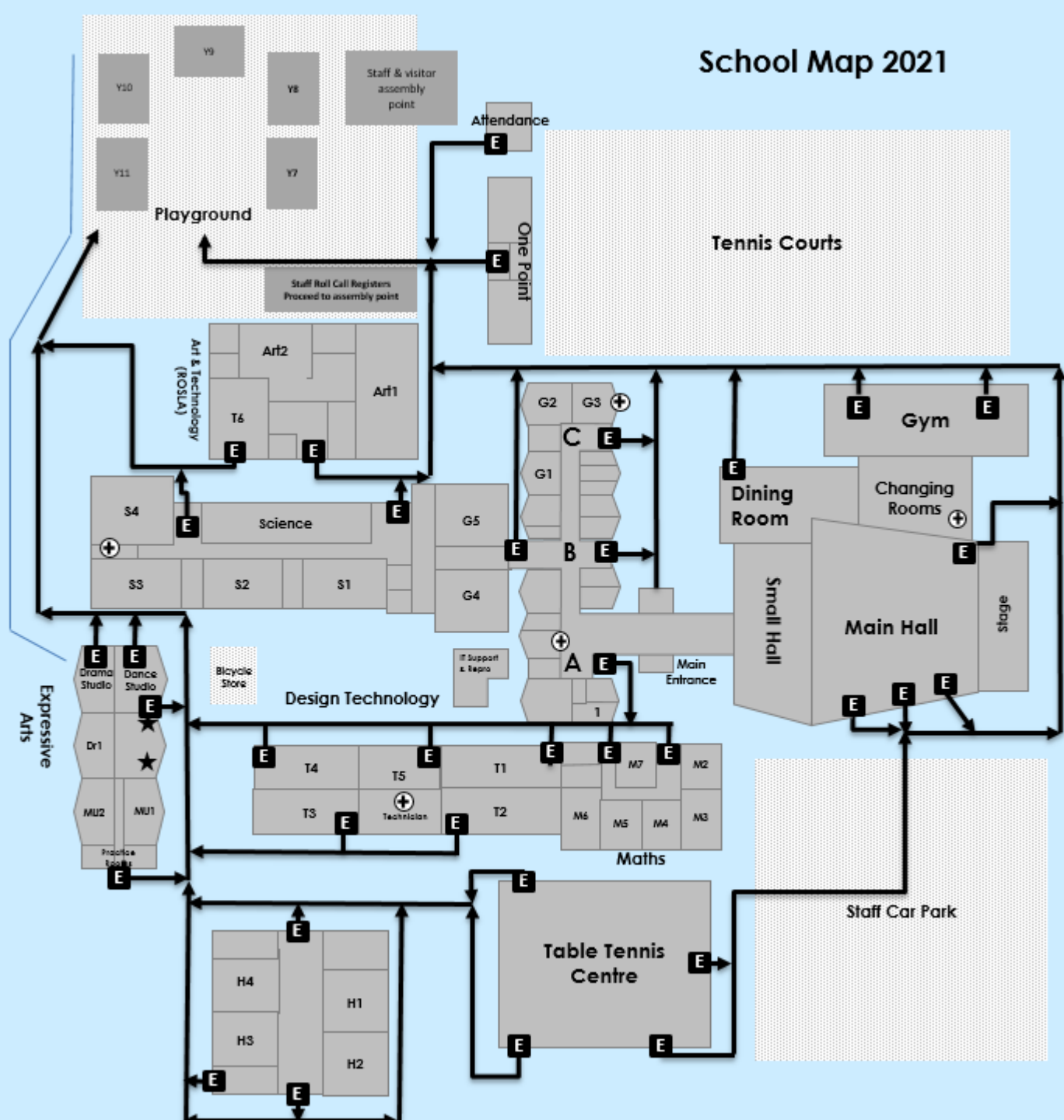

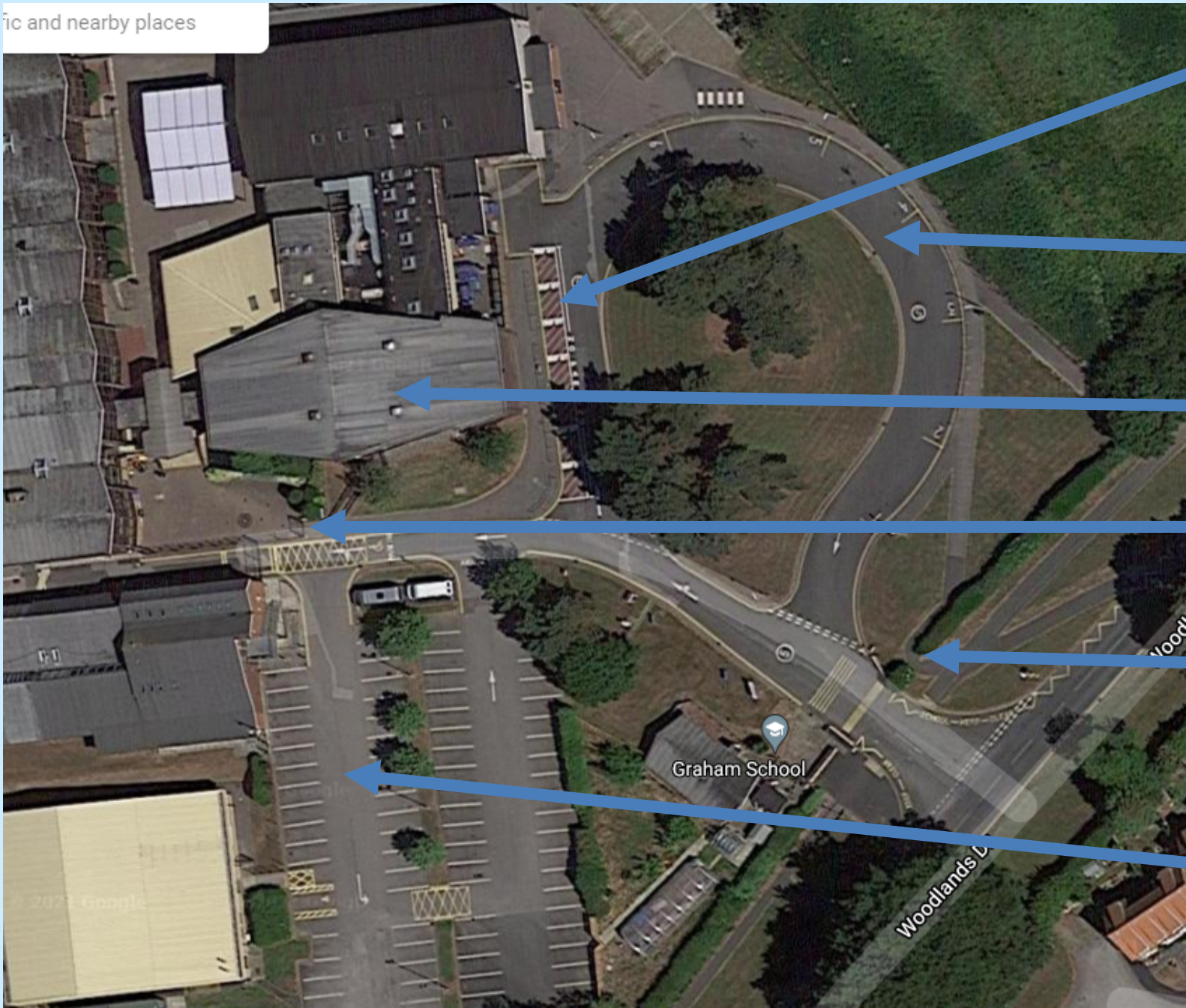




Graham School is a situated in a large site, however, subjects are usually taught in a dedicated building so remembering which building is which subject is much easier than remembering where all the rooms are!

Rewards

Our rewards and behaviour systems are all located in the student planner. These will be given out in September.

Here is an example of the rewards page. Students receive reward stamps from all staff in school and the points are added up and can be cashed in for prizes throughout the year.

A list of rewards for next year will be made available to students in September.

Our planner also includes our behaviour system which is briefly outlined on the next slide.

The pages are side by side in the planner at the end of each week so parents can view the details when signing on a weekly basis.
