REWARDS DAY TUESDAY 20TH JULY 2021

On Tuesday 20th July, Graham School will be holding a 'Rewards Day'. This year the event will be a full day of activities, challenges and sports events aimed at all year groups. We are incredibly proud of how our students have responded to the challenges of the last two academic years; we are therefore, organising this event to bring the school together again as one community, after all the disruption caused by Covid-19.

The students will be encouraged to get involved in a range of activities across 4 different zones including; Silly Sports Zone, The Fun Zone, the inflatable Zone and the Activities Zone. In addition, each Year 7 tutor group will be organising their own stall, activity and/or service in order to raise money for The Rainbow Centre.

The school start time will be 8.40am as usual, and students will finish school at 2.55pm. The day will be a 'Sportswear Day', therefore, all students should arrive to school in appropriate sportswear including a t-shirt and jumper and either tracksuit bottoms, sweat pants, shorts or leggings; appropriate sports footwear must also be worn, as some activities require students to be wearing trainers. Students will also need to dress appropriately for the weather, if it is raining then students will need a waterproof coat and if it is a sunny day, students will require sun cream, hats and a bottle that they can fill with water. There will be a hydration station for water and a first aid area available on the day.

Students will need to bring some money with them if they wish to purchase items on offer at the charity stalls, such as cakes, sweets, face painting, hair braiding etc. all of this money will go to The Rainbow Centre.

The activities on offer for your child to get involved in include: Bungee Trampolines, Bungee Dash and Grab, Meltdown, Wipe-Out, an inflatable boot camp/assault course, a climbing wall, mountain biking, Bubble Football, Danceacise, table tennis, volleyball, giant games, crazy golf, penalty shootout, the unclimbable Ladders, Bungee Trampolines, Laser Battle Zone, Segway's, tug of war, egg and spoon race... to name just a few!

We will, of course, continue to follow any government guidelines around Covid-19 and students will remain in their 'bubbles'. Please rest assured, we will risk asses everything carefully with the health, safety and well-being of all students as our central priority. We just ask that you ensure that your child completes their Covid Test the night before the event.
