

### Key Stage 1 and 2:

Ancient civilisations: Egypt, Greece or Rome  
World study: China, Africa or South America  
British history: Pre-historic to the Anglo-Saxons  
Theme study and Local history study

### Year 7:

**Content:** Norman England, the Middle Ages, the Tudors, the Stuarts and the Civil Wars.

**Skills:** Chronology, measuring time, evidence, bias, reliability, utility, explanation and argument.

### Year 8:

**Content:** The Industrial Revolution, British Empire, crime and punishment, local history, the First and Second World Wars, the Holocaust.

**Skills:** Chronology, evidence, bias, reliability, utility, provenance, interpretation, explanation and argument.

### Year 10:

**Content:** GCSE unit 2 – Norman England, c1066-c1100, including the Historic Environment study;  
GCSE unit 3 – Power and the people: c1170 to the present day (12 case studies)

**Skills:** Develop GCSE source evaluation and analysis, reliability, utility, purpose, provenance; explanation of second-order concepts, essay writing and supported argument.

### Year 9:

**Content:** The French Revolution, the Russian Revolution and the Cold War  
GCSE unit 1 – Germany, 1890-1945: Democracy and dictatorship

**Skills:** GCSE source evaluation and analysis, bias, reliability, utility, purpose, provenance; explanation of second-order concepts, essay writing and supported argument.

### Year 11:

**Content:** GCSE unit 4 – Conflict and tension: The inter-war years, 1918-1939

**Skills:** Mastery of GCSE source evaluation and analysis, reliability, utility, purpose, provenance; explanation of second-order concepts, essay writing skills and supported argument.

### Key Stage 5 and beyond:

**Further education:** A Level history (British and global), combined with other humanities subjects, social sciences, politics and law.

**Careers:** Civil service, government, legal professions, police, teaching, heritage occupations, journalism and the media.
